1-Committee leader - responsible for the overall organization and execution of the race. Must be able to operate the committee boat and must have a reasonable knowledge of racing rules and the manner in which races are conducted.

2-Time keeper - will act as an assistant to the committee leader. Must be able to assist in handing the committee boat and will be required to co-ordinate flag signals and record results.

3-Crash Boat Operator - must be able to handle the crash boats during rescue operations and will be expected to direct the layout of course markers under the direction of the Committee leader.

4-Crash Boat Assistant - must be able to provide required assistance during rescue operations and to handle marks during course layout..
